BATTERIES - Alkaline/Rechargeable 50 cents/pound
BATTERIES - Lead Acid 25 cents/pound

FLUORESCENT LIGHTS - Compact \$1
FLUORESCENT LIGHTS - 4' and less \$1
FLUORESCENT LIGHTS - 5' and up \$2
HIGH INTENSITY DISCHARGE LIGHTS \$2

SHOES - Wearable Pairs Only No charge

APPLIANCES - Freon-containing: \$25
-refrigerators, air-conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.

APPLIANCES - All others: \$5
-washers, hot-water tanks, stoves, etc.

TIRES - Passenger Vehicle: \$3
TIRES - Light Truck: \$5
TIRES - On Rims: \$10
TIRES - Tractor Trailer: \$10
TIRES - Tractor Trailer on Rims: \$20
